ABSTRACT

The contemporary history of Andalusia cannot be explained without considering the industrial processes that, between the late 18th and 20th centuries, transformed landscapes, reorganised societies and left a material and symbolic mark that today constitutes an enormously rich heritage, although one that is not sufficiently recognised.

The monograph “Industrial Heritage in Andalusia” analyses, in ten articles, the economic history, intangible heritage and image of industry, while offering key methodological tools such as cartography and discussion of archival research. The aim is to delve deeper into this productive legacy, as well as to explore the challenges of reusing what has been inherited and the crucial transition from archaeology to management, which is essential for its survival. Taken together, it proposes a multidisciplinary vision to project the wealth of Andalusia's industrial heritage into the future, redefining its role in the historical, social and cultural narrative.
