ABSTRACT

The conquest of political autonomy is the most significant contribution from Andalusia to the history of the Transition to Democracy in Spain. After the death of the dictator Francisco Franco, Andalusian people demanded amnesty, freedom and democracy, as well as a project of territorial articulation of a country, in which Andalusia was put behind for decades. These pages go across the massive demonstration in December the 4th, 1977, the big political agreement signed in Antequera a year later by all democratic parties, and the social process that led to the referendum of February the 28th, 1980.
