

# ANDALUCÍA EN LA HISTORIA

**Nº81: Thousand years in the Kingdom of Seville**



## ABSTRACT

The new issue of the magazine 'Andalucía en la Historia' commemorates the millennium of the foundation of the Kingdom of Seville. Created in November 1023 by the first monarch of the Abadi dynasty, Abul Qasim, it had a very wide extension, varying over the centuries, to include the current provinces of Seville, Huelva, Cadiz, some localities of Cordoba, north of Malaga and the south of Badajoz, and even reaching -in the Abadi stage- from Silves (in Portugal) to Murcia. After 1492, it was the main port for the shipments to America, it has been strategic for the Spanish Monarchie untill the nineteenth century.
